

PRODUCT **Calamine BP**

CAS no. 8011-96-9

DESCRIPTION Calamine is a basic zinc carbonate suitably coloured with iron(III) oxide.

CHARACTERISTICS An amorphous, impalpable, pink or reddish brown powder, the colour depending on the variety and amount of iron(III) oxide present and the process by which it is incorporated.
Practically insoluble in water. It dissolves with effervescence in HCl.
